

# City of Blythe Residential Solid Waste and Recycling Services Guide



## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

- 1 Carts should be placed at the curbside no later than 6:00 am on collection day and should be placed with handles and wheels facing towards your home.
- 2 Lids should be closed. Please do not overload.
- 3 Carts should be removed from the curbside within 12 hours of service.
- 4 Items placed outside of carts will not be collected.
- 5 Residents may order additional carts if needed. Additional monthly charges will apply. Please call our office for more information.

## ITEMS ACCEPTED IN RECYCLING CART:

The following is a partial list of recycling materials that can be placed in your Blue Recycling Cart:

- Newspapers
- Aluminum cans
- Plastic/glass bottles
- Cardboard
- Tin cans
- Magazines
- Junk Mail
- Phone Books
- Cereal Boxes
- Computer Paper

Please place all **RECYCLABLES** in your **BLUE CART** and all **TRASH** in your **BLACK CART**.

## ADDITIONAL SERVICES

### HOUSEHOLD BATTERY DISPOSAL

If you have used household batteries [AAA, AA, C, D, etc.] at home, please do not throw them away in your trash receptacle. You can dispose of them free of charge by dropping them off at Blythe City Hall. Battery collection receptacles are made available for your convenience.

### COMMUNITY CLEAN-UPS


Residents will have the opportunity to participate in our Annual Community Clean-Up Event. In addition to trash and bulky item disposal, residents will be able to dispose of e-waste. Date and time will be made available prior to the event. Proof of Blythe residency will be required.

### RESIDENTIAL GREENWASTE DROP OFF

Residents may drop their greenwaste off **FREE OF CHARGE** at CR&R's yard located at 14701 S. Broadway. For more information, please visit our website or call our Customer Service Team. Proof of Blythe residency will be required.

### BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

Residents are entitled to "on-call" bulky item collection, up to four times per year. Please call our Customer Service Team to schedule a pickup of large items that do not fit in your carts like furniture and/or appliances.
